

Bike expedition to Leh- Nubra and Turtuk (India Pakistan Border) Ladakh Region, August 2014

Day	Date	Itinerary
01	3 rd August	Departure to Ambala by Swaraj Express, Night in train.
02	4 th August	Arrival in Ambala as per train schedule 7:30am, take possession of own motorbikes and ride to Chandigarh. Rest for the day in Chandigarh. N.H Chandigarh. D Ambala to Chandigarh appox distance 50 kms.
03	5 th August	Early morning after breakfast start the ride from Chandigarh to Manali, Reach Manali by evening, N.H.Manali, B-D. Chandigarh to Manali appox distance 310 kms.
04	6 th August	Early morning after breakfast start the ride from Manali to Jispa, Reach Jispa through Rohtang Pass 13080 ft, by early evening, N.H.Jispa, B-D. Manali to Jispa appox distance 130 kms.
05	7 th August	Early morning after breakfast start the ride from Jispa to Leh, Reach Leh through Baralacha la Pass and Taglangla Pass World's second highest Motorable Road in the World, by evening, N.H.Leh, B-D. Jispa to Leh appox distance 335 kms.
06	8 th August	Rest day in Leh city, service the motorbikes if required and take proper rest at the hotel. N.H.Leh, B-D
07	9 th August	Ride to Nubra Valley and Hundar cold desert of the Himalayas via Khardungla Pass, the world's highest motorable road at 18380ft above sea level. N.H Nubra Hundar, B-D. Leh to Nubra appox distance 110 kms.
08	10 th August	Ride from Hundar to Turtuk (last village on India Pakistan border 100 kms one way) return to Hundar, N.H.Hundar. B-D packed lunch will also be provided.Total ride will be 200 kms.
09	11 th August	Early morning ride back to Leh from Hundar, reach Leh by late afternoon, relax at hotel. N.H.Leh, B. Hundar to Leh appox distance 110 Kms.
10	12 th August	Ride from Leh to Pangong Lake (Asia's brackish salt water lake,145 kms ride one way) return toLeh, N.H.Leh. B-D. Total ride will be 290 kms.
11	13 th August	Rest day in Leh city, service the motorbikes if required and take proper rest at the hotel. N.H.Leh, B.
12	14 th August	Early morning after breakfast start the ride from Leh to Kargil enroute Magnetic hill and Lamayaru monastery. N.H.Kargil, B-D. Leh to Kargil appox distance 230 kms.
13	15 th August	Early morning after breakfast start the ride from Kargil to Sonmarg. N.H.Sonmarg, B-D. Kargil to Sonmarg appox distance 120 kms.

14	16 th August	Early morning after breakfast start the ride from Sonmarg to Jammu. N.H.Jammu, B. Sonmarg to Jammu approx distance 360 kms.
15	17 th August	After breakfast checkout from hotel, and proceed to respective home towns. B.

B- Breakfast, L- Lunch, D-Dinner. N.H- Night halt

Terms and Conditions for the participants of the Bike Expedition.

The organisers reserve the right to suspend a participant if he/she fails to produce original documents on the day of reporting, also if the bike bought is not in proper condition or is modified.

Misbehaving or violating rules and regulations set by the organisers will also lead to suspension of the participant. In case of suspension the participant does not get any refund, and he has to leave the group with immediate effect and bear all expenses by himself.

The participant may withdraw his/her participation at any time during the expedition in writing to the organisers. Under such circumstances it is the responsibility of the participant to arrange and bear the cost for subsequent onward travel, food and accommodation for himself/herself.

The organisers reserve the right to cancel the bike expedition or to alter or reduce the route including the starting and finishing point.

Cancellation Rules for the Participant: If the participant decides to withdraw his/her participation 30 days before the commencement of the bike expedition he/she will be entitled for 30% amount refund of the participation charges paid by him/her.

Cancellations received after that will not be entitled for any refund under any circumstances.
